## UNNC Elections 2007

UNITED NEIGHBORHOODS OF THE HISTORIC ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, WEST ADAMS AND JEFFERSON PARK COMMUNITIES NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL (UNNC) is holding elections for three (3) At Large Non-resident Representatives on its Governing Board.

The UNNC board is made up of your neighbors. Our mission is to empower and bring together our diverse community by providing a public forum to determine and address our community's needs.

**Boundaries:** south side of Pico Boulevard from Crenshaw to Normandie, north side of Rodeo Road between Crenshaw & Arlington, west side of Normandie from Pico south to the 10 Freeway, west to the west side of Western Avenue from the 10 Freeway south to Jefferson Boulevard and west to the east side of Arlington south to Rodeo Road, and, the east side of Crenshaw from Pico to Rodeo. A UNNC stakeholder is anyone 14 years and older who lives, works, owns property, or otherwise identifies themselves as a stakeholder in the UNNC region based upon participation in, among other things, parks, public safety organizations, environmental organizations, medical/health organizations, libraries, educational institutions, religious institutions, community organizations, service organizations, or other at large groups. Any Stakeholder may be a candidate, and all Stakeholders may vote.
