Processes and Procedures Ordinance (ReCodeLA)**

The Processes and Procedures Ordinance will be the second major part of the larger effort to update the City's Zoning Code. The proposal will lay the groundwork, according to the Planning Department, "for a more user-friendly set of guidelines." The proposed ordinance will also retain "long-standing opportunities for public comment." The Planning Department will give a presentation, answer questions, and conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, June 26, at the Ronald F. Deaton Civic Auditorium, 100 W. 1st Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, from 6:00 p.m to 8:00 p.m.
