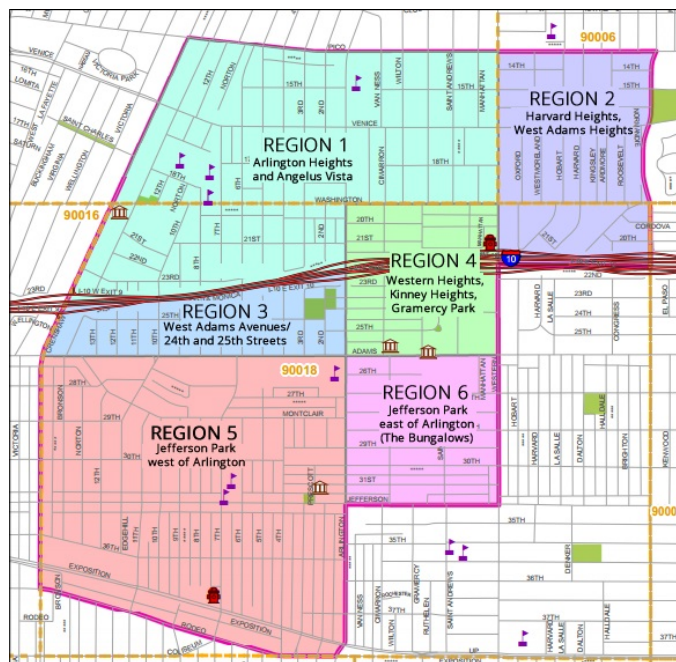

Become a Serving Board Member

The United Neighborhoods Governing Board consists of 23 Board seats. 12 board seats (area representatives) are designated for residents of the six region areas (see Map) within the neighborhood council boundaries and 11 seats (at-large representatives) are for non-resident stakeholders such as business, education, non-profit, cultural heritage and at large interests. The board is elected by stakeholders. "Stakeholders" are those who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it based upon their participation in among other things, parks, recreation areas, public safety organizations, environmental organizations, medical/health organizations, libraries, educational institutions, religious institutions, community organizations, service organizations, non-profit organizations, or other at large entities which have an address within UNNC's boundaries.

Responsibilities

1). MONTHLY MEETING ATTENDANCE

All UNNC board members attend monthly governing board meetings on the first Thursday of every month. As of May, 2020, UNNC Board and Committee meetings are held virtually, via Zoom (online and telephonically). It is not known at this point when in-person meetings will resume.

2). CODE OF CIVILITY

All UNNC board members agree to a Code of Civility and to comply with UNNC Board Rules.

3). VOLUNTEER

All UNNC board members agree to volunteer for UNNC-sponsored events and projects.

4). DONE COMPLIANCE

All UNNC board members must comply with the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) regulations.

5). TRAINING + WORKSHOPS

UNNC Board Members are required to take the Code of Conduct, Funding Program Training, and the Ethics Training, plus any other workshops and mandatory training sessions to further one's awareness of DONE procedures and City requirements.
