Location: southeast corner of Adams and Montclair, within the Crenshaw Corridor Specific Plan and the Adams Boulevard Scenic Highway. Proposed project's common areas include on site property management offices, a community room, laundry facilities as well as outdoor hardscaped and landscaped courtyards.
