Los Angeles Sanitation is a leader in waste diversion from landfills. 62% diverted. Goal is to divert 75%. RenewLA has a zero waste plan. 6 Solid waste regions- called wastesheds. Also working on greenhouse gas reduction.

There are multiple technologies for disposing black bin waste: composting, such as gasification, pyrolysis, plasma arc.

Proposing to divert 1000 tons per day to produce electricity.

Phase I complete –RFP. A worldwide study was conducted to review existing installations. Phase II is selection.

Plan is to initiate permitting in 2009. 2009-2010 permits. 2011 constructions. 2012 facility commissioning.
