### MINUTES

Vice President Billie Green opened the meeting at 7:39 p.m. A quorum was present.

Members present: Stevie Stern, Billie Green, Norman Gilmore.

Members absent: Wesley Todd

Agenda approved unanimously.

Public comments: Don't forget to promote Movies in the Park this June 19<sup>th</sup>.

**MOTION:** Stevie Stern moved to amend agenda with funding request for Harvard Heights Neighborhood presented by Gary Rieck.

Seconded and approved unanimously.

Todd Hunter presented a funding request from Arlington Heights / Avenues of Washington. The funding request is for about 10 banners and signs for National Night Out Against Crime \$640-\$960. Three estimates were solicited. Signs are re-usable by different groups since there are no dates or block club names on the signs.

Todd Hunter presented Avenues Neighborhood Watch Association funding request to have the Washington Blvd Stop in Center professionally cleaned by a licensed cleaning service.

The amount requested is \$270.

**MOTION:** Stevie Stern moved to forward to the full board the request for up to \$270 to clean the Washington Blvd Stop in Center. Norman Gilmore seconded.

Approved unanimously.

**MOTION:** Stevie Stern moved to forward to the full board the request for up to \$960 for banners and signs for the National Night Out Against Crime, subject to the UNNC logo and name to being incorporated into the design. Norman Gilmore seconded.

Gary Rieck presented a funding request from Harvard Heights Neighborhood Association for 50 block meeting yard signs and one large banner. Material would be durable and re-usable. Signs would be English / Spanish. Currently printing 550 flyers per month.

The UNNC name and logo will be incorporated into the design. Preliminary estimate has come in at \$1300 dollars.
